You will need to collect hair cautiously from the mane or tail of the horse and place it neatly into a small zip-lock bag or paper envelope. The sample must be clearly labelled with your horse's name and the case reference number provided in your confirmation email. This same case reference number must also be written in BLOCK CAPITALS in the Privileged Order Number field below.

SAMPLE COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE NOTE: Hair samples can be collected by the horse owner. The process is simple, but it is important to follow the instructions carefully to ensure the sample is suitable for testing. We will not be sending out a test kit for this analysis — all the guidance you need is provided below.

After collecting the sample, please sign your name on the sample bag. Hair should be taken from the mane or tail, not the body, and placed in a clean zip-lock bag or envelope clearly labelled with the horse's name and your case reference number.

To collect a suitable sample, you will need:

- Clean hands
- A mane comb
- A self-sealing bag or paper envelope for the sample

Before collecting the hair, thoroughly wash and dry your hands. Make sure the mane comb is clean and free from hair or debris. Comb through the horse's mane or tail to remove any loose material. Then, cut or gently pull 12 to 25 strands of clean hair from the mane or tail. The root bulb is not required for this test. Ensure the hairs are dry and free from dirt or contaminants before sealing them in the bag or envelope.

Alternatively, you may collect the sample from a grooming brush, provided the brush has only been used on the horse in question and there is no risk of cross-contamination from other animals.

If you are collecting samples from more than one horse, wash your hands thoroughly or use clean disposable gloves between collections. This helps to prevent any risk of cross-contamination. Repeat the full process for each horse
